FEMA Damage Matrix: Affected (For Conventionally Built Homes)

Definition:

Residences with minimal damage to the exterior and/or contents of the home.


Flood Examples:

 Any water line in the crawl space or basement when essential living space or mechanicalc components are not damaged or submerged

Non-Flood Examples:

- Partial missing shingles or siding
- Cosmetic damage such as paint discoloration or loose siding
- Broken screens
- Gutter damage and debris
- Damage to an attached structure such as a porch, carport, garage, or outbuilding not for commercial use
- Damage to landscaping, retaining walls, or downed trees that do not affect access to the residence

NON-FLOOD DAMAGE: CONVENTIONALLY BUILT HOMES



EXAMPLES:

- Partial missing shingles or siding
- Cosmetic damage such as paint discoloration or loose siding
- Broken screens, gutter damage, or debris
- Damage to an attached structure such as a porch, carport, garage, or outbuilding not for commerical use
- Damage to landscaping, retaining walls, or downed trees that do not affect access to the residence

AFFECTED - NON-FLOOD
