

**FEMA Damage Matrix: Minor  
(For Structures Except Manufactured Housing)**

**Definition:**  
*Encompasses a wide range of damage that does not affect the structural integrity of the residence.*


**Flood Examples:**

Water line up to 18 inches in an essential living space.  
Damage to mechanical components (e.g. furnace, boiler, water heater, HVAC, etc.).

**Non-Flood Examples:**

Non-structural damage to roof components over essential living space to include shingles e.g. roof covering, fascia board, soffit, flashing, and skylight. Non-structural damage to the interior wall components to include drywall, insulation. Non-structural damage to exterior components. Multiple small vertical cracks in the foundation. Damage to chimney to include, tilting, fallen, cracks, or separated from the residence. Damage to mechanical components (e.g. furnace, boiler, water heater, HVAC, etc.). Damage or disaster related contamination to a private well or septic system.
